AN ACT

To amend chapter 217, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to correctional facilities.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 217, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 217.061, to read as follows:

217.061. 1. The attorney general shall ensure that each volunteer who offers to work with prisoners at any correctional center or city or county jail is screened for known and suspected international and domestic terrorist connections or proclivities, using all available files of the Missouri state highway patrol and the Federal Bureau of Investigation and requiring the volunteer to make available social media accounts for screening purposes.

2. It shall be the duty of the attorney general to require appropriate action in the case of each volunteer whose screening raises questions about terrorist connections or proclivities.

3. Not later than December 1, 2016, the director shall study specific procedures in place to reduce the instances of terrorist radicalization during imprisonment and report the results of that study to the joint committee on the justice system and the joint committee on government accountability.
