AN ACT

To amend chapter 262, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to working animals.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 262, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new 2 section, to be known as section 262.760, to read as follows:

- 262.760. 1. No political subdivision shall impose any order,
- 2 ordinance, policy, or regulation prohibiting the use of a working animal
- 3 unless such use poses a reasonable threat to public health, safety, or
- 4 welfare, or to the health and welfare of the working animal, but each
- 5 political subdivision may adopt reasonable rules and regulations
- 6 governing such animals so long as such rules and regulations are not
- 7 intended to ban the use of such working animals for entertainment,
- 8 transportation, or educational exhibits.
- 9 2. No political subdivision shall impose any order, ordinance,
- 10 policy, or regulation prohibiting working animals on public streets
- 11 unless such street, or time of day for a particular street, poses a
- 12 reasonable threat to public health, safety, or welfare, or to the health
- 13 and welfare of the working animal, but each political subdivision may
- 14 adopt orders, ordinances, policies, and regulations that further the
- 15 public health, safety, and welfare.
 - 3. The provisions of subsection 2 of this section shall not apply

- 17 to:
- 18 (1) Mounted peace officers;
- 19 (2) Parades and public celebrations;
- 20 (3) Horses or ponies measuring less than forty inches as
- 21 measured from the last hairs of the mane, which are at the withers.
- 4. For purposes of this section, "working animal" shall mean the
- 23 use of any animal for the purpose of performing a specific duty or
- 24 function in entertainment, transportation, or educational exhibits.
