AN ACT

To repeal section 89.320, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to qualifications for members of municipal planning commissions.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 89.320, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted
2 in lieu thereof, to be known as section 89.320, to read as follows:

89.320. The planning commission of any municipality shall consist of not
2 more than fifteen nor less than seven members, including:

3 (1) The mayor, if the mayor chooses to be a member;

4 (2) A member of the council selected by the council, if the council chooses
5 to have a member serve on the commission; and

6 (3) Not more than fifteen nor less than five **[citizens] residents of the**
7 **municipality** appointed by the mayor and approved by the council. All **[citizen]**
8 **resident** members of the commission shall serve without compensation. The
9 term of each of the **[citizen] resident** members shall be for four years, except
10 that the terms of the **[citizen] resident** members first appointed shall be for
11 varying periods so that succeeding terms will be staggered. Any vacancy in a
12 membership shall be filled for the unexpired term by appointment as
13 aforesaid. The council may remove any **[citizen] resident** member for cause
14 stated in writing and after public hearing.
