AN ACT

To amend chapter 542, RSMo, by adding thereto two new sections relating to law enforcement agency investigations.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 542, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto two new sections, to be known as sections 542.293 and 542.294, to read as follows:

542.293. Law enforcement agencies of this state are prohibited from indiscriminately gathering, maintaining, or disseminating intelligence information about persons engaged solely in lawful activity, unless there is reasonable suspicion, supported by sufficient and articulable facts, that the subject of the information is or may be involved in criminal conduct or activity.

542.294. 1. All law enforcement officers shall first obtain a search warrant, as provided in this chapter, prior to the search or seizure of garbage or trash located on a street curb or within the curtilage of a residence or privately owned building awaiting collection and disposal.

2. Upon placement of garbage or trash on a street curb or within the curtilage of a residence for collection by a provider of solid waste collection services, ownership of the garbage or trash shall transfer to the service provider.
