AN ACT

To repeal sections 620.2450 and 620.2451, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof two new sections relating to grants to expand broadband internet access in unserved and underserved areas of the state.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

- Section A. Sections 620.2450 and 620.2451, RSMo, are
- 2 repealed and two new sections enacted in lieu thereof, to be
- 3 known as sections 620.2450 and 620.2451, to read as follows:
 - 620.2450. 1. A grant program is hereby established
- 2 under sections 620.2450 to 620.2458 to award grants to
- 3 applicants who seek to expand access to broadband internet
- 4 service in unserved and underserved areas of the state. The
- 5 department of economic development shall administer and act
- 6 as the fiscal agent for the grant program and shall be
- 7 responsible for receiving and reviewing grant applications
- 8 and awarding grants under sections 620.2450 to 620.2458.
- 9 Funding for the grant program established under this section
- 10 shall be subject to appropriation by the general assembly.
- 11 2. As used in sections 620.2450 to 620.2458, the
- 12 following terms shall mean:
- 13 (1) "Project", the acquisition and installation of
- 14 retail broadband internet service in unserved and
- underserved areas of the state;

- 16 (2) "Underserved area", a project area without access
 17 to wireline or fixed wireless broadband internet service of
 18 speeds of [at least twenty-five] the higher of:
- 19 (a) One hundred megabits per-second download and
 20 [three] twenty megabits per-second upload; or
- 21 (b) The minimum speed established by the Federal 22 Communications Commission as authorized in 7 U.S.C. 23 950bb(e)(2).
- [(2)] (3) "Unserved area", a project area without access to wireline or fixed wireless broadband internet service of speeds of at least [ten] twenty-five megabits persecond download and [one] three megabit per-second upload.
- 620.2451. 1. Grants awarded under sections 620.2450
 to 620.2458 shall fund the acquisition and installation of
 retail broadband internet service [at], prioritizing
 projects providing speeds of [at least twenty-five] the
 higher of:
- 6 (1) One hundred megabits per-second download and
 7 [three] twenty megabits per-second upload[, but] that is
 8 scalable to higher speeds; or
- 9 (2) The minimum acceptable speed established by the 10 Federal Communications Commission as authorized in 7 U.S.C. 11 950bb(e)(2).
- 12 The department shall maintain a record of all federal grants awarded to entities for the purposes of 13 14 providing, maintaining, and expanding rural broadband in the state of Missouri. In cases in which funds have been 15 awarded by a federal agency but later retained, withheld, or 16 otherwise not distributed to the original grant recipient 17 due to failure to meet performance standards or other 18 criteria, the department shall seek to have the funds 19

20 awarded to another eligible, qualified Missouri broadband
