## AN ACT

To repeal section 8.010, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the board of public buildings.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Section 8.010, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted  
2 in lieu thereof, to be known as section 8.010, to read as follows:

8.010. 1. The governor, attorney general, **speaker of the house of**  
2 **representatives, president pro tempore of the senate,** and lieutenant  
3 governor constitute the board of public buildings. The governor is chairman and  
4 the lieutenant governor, secretary. [The speaker of the house of representatives  
5 and the president pro tempore of the senate shall serve as ex officio members of  
6 the board but shall not have the power to vote.] The board shall constitute a body  
7 corporate and politic. The board has general supervision and charge of the public  
8 property of the state at the seat of government and other duties imposed on it by  
9 law.

10 2. The commissioner of administration shall provide staff support to the  
11 board.
