
### Description of fiscal impact

HB 166 removes the termination date of June 30, 2025, from the statutorily appropriated state special revenue accounts: Montana Historical Interpretation, 22-3-115, MCA, and Montana Historical Society Membership, 22-3-116, MCA. There is no net fiscal impact.

### FISCAL ANALYSIS

#### Assumptions

- The Montana Historical Interpretation and Montana Historical Society Membership state special revenue accounts are set to sunset June 30, 2025. HB 166 removes the sunsets allowing the statutorily appropriated accounts to continue.
