

HOUSE BILL NO. 114

INTRODUCED BY C. CLARK

BY REQUEST OF THE DEPARTMENT OF LIVESTOCK

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REVISING THE DEFINITION OF "GARBAGE" FOR USE AS ANIMAL FEED; AND AMENDING SECTION 81-2-501, MCA."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 81-2-501, MCA, is amended to read:

"81-2-501. Definitions. When used in this part, the following definitions apply:

(1) "Garbage" means ~~putrescible animal and vegetable~~ wastes resulting from the handling, preparation, cooking, and consumption of ~~foods~~ animal products, including animal carcasses ~~or parts thereof~~ OR PARTS OF ANIMAL CARCASSES, OR OTHER REFUSE OF ANY CHARACTER THAT HAS BEEN ASSOCIATED WITH ANY ANIMAL PRODUCTS, INCLUDING ANIMAL CARCASSES OR PARTS OF ANIMAL CARCASSES.

(2) "Garbage feeder" means a person who handles, prepares, cooks, or otherwise treats garbage to feed to swine or other animals, as well as a person who feeds garbage to swine or other animals.

(3) "Person" means the state, any municipality, political subdivision, school district, institution, public or private corporation, individual, partnership, or other entity."
