4	A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REVISING THE DISPLAY OF SAMPLE BALLOTS AT POLLING
5	PLACES; ELIMINATING THE REQUIREMENT TO POST SAMPLE BALLOTS AT EACH VOTING STATION;
6	AND AMENDING SECTION 13-13-112, MCA."

8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10	Section 1. Section 13-13-112, MCA, is amended to read:
11	"13-13-112. Display of instructions for electors. (1) Except as provided in subsection (3), instructions
12	for electors on how to prepare their ballots or use a voting system must be posted in each voting station provided
13	for the preparation of ballots.
14	(2) The instructions must be in easily read type, 18 point or larger, and explain:
15	(a) how to obtain ballots for voting;
16	(b) how to prepare ballots, including how to:
17	(i) cast a valid vote, including a valid vote for a write-in candidate;
18	(ii) correct a mistake; and
19	(iii) ensure the proper disposition of the ballot after the elector is finished voting;
20	(c) how to obtain a new ballot in place of one spoiled by accident; and
21	(d) how to vote provisionally pursuant to 13-13-601.
22	(3) The information required in subsection (2) must also be posted at each polling place along with the
23	election date, the hours the polls are open, and instructions for mail-in registrants and first-time voters.
24	(4) If the instructions for use of a voting system are printed on the system or are part of a ballot package
25	given to each elector, separate instructions need not be posted in the voting station.
26	(5) Sample ballots, clearly marked "sample" across the face, must be posted at each voting station and
27	in <u>at least one</u> conspicuous places around the <u>location at each</u> polling place."
