9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11	Section 1. Section 69-8-603, MCA, is amended to read:
12	"69-8-603. Net energy measurement calculation. Consistent with the other provisions of this part, the
13	net energy measurement must be calculated in the following manner:
14	(1) The <u>public</u> utility shall measure the net electricity produced or consumed during the billing period, in
15	accordance with normal metering practices.
16	(2) If the electricity supplied by the electricity supplier public utility exceeds the electricity generated by
17	the customer-generator and fed back to the electricity supplier public utility during the billing period, the
18	customer-generator must be billed for the net electricity supplied by the electricity supplier public utility, in
19	accordance with normal metering practices.
20	(3) If the electricity generated by the customer-generator exceeds the electricity supplied by the electricity
21	supplier public utility, the customer-generator must be:
22	(a) billed for the appropriate customer charges for that billing period, in accordance with 69-8-602; and
23	(b) credited for the excess kilowatt hours generated during the billing period, with this kilowatt-hour credit
24	credits appearing on the bill for the following billing period.
25	(4) On January 1, April 1, July 1, or October 1 of each every second year, as designated by the
26	customer-generator as the beginning date of a 12-month 24-month billing period, any remaining unused
27	kilowatt-hour credit credits accumulated during the previous 12 months 24 months must be granted to the
28	electricity supplier public utility, without any compensation to the customer-generator."

30	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Effective date. [This act] is effective July 1, 2015.
