9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Law enforcement officers and firefighters critically injured in line of
12	duty. A law enforcement officer, as defined in 7-32-201, a firefighter, or a volunteer firefighter who was critically
13	injured in the line of duty and is unable to return to work because of the injury is entitled to fish with a wildlife
14	conservation license issued by the department during expeditions arranged for the person by a nonprofit
15	organization that uses fishing as part of the rehabilitation of injured or disabled persons.

17	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
18	integral part of Title 87, chapter 2, part 8, and the provisions of Title 87, chapter 2, part 8, apply to [section 1].

20	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval.
