7	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Assault on health care provider or emergency responder penalty
10	definitions. (1) A person commits the offense of assault on a health care provider or emergency responde
11	if, while a health care provider or emergency responder is performing professional duties, the person:
12	(a) purposely or knowingly causes bodily injury to the health care provider or emergency responder;
13	(b) negligently causes bodily injury to the health care provider or emergency responder with a weapon
14	or
15	(c) purposely or knowingly causes the health care provider or emergency responder reasonable
16	apprehension of bodily injury.
17	(2) A person convicted of assault on a health care provider or emergency responder shall be fined an
18	amount not to exceed \$50,000 or be imprisoned for a term not to exceed 10 years, or both.
19	(3) (a) Except as provided in subsection (3)(b), the requirements of 45-5-206(4) through (7) and 45-5-232
20	through 45-5-234 apply to a person convicted under this section.
21	(b) The provisions of 45-5-206(4)(b)(iii) do not apply to this section.
22	(4) As used in this section, the following definitions apply:
23	(a) "Emergency responder" has the meaning provided in 45-5-214.
24	(b) "Health care provider" has the meaning provided in 50-4-504.

27	integral part of Title 45, chapter 5, part 2, and the provisions of Title 45, chapter 5, part 2, apply to [section 1].
