| 18 | preparing the Montana national guard for active duty ordered by the governor under Article VI, section 13, of the |
| 19 | $\underline{\textbf{Montana constitution}} \ \underline{\textbf{performed by Montana national guard personnel within the scope of the department's duties}.$ |
