14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

16	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Article IX of The Constitution of the State of Montana is amended by adding		
17	a new section 8 that reads:		
18	Section 8. Oil and gas trust fund. (1) The legislature shall dedicate the following percentages of any		
19	tax collected by the state on the extraction, severance, or production of oil and gas, but not including any tax		
20	based on the value of the property and collected by the counties, to a trust fund, the interest and income from		
21	which may be appropriated:		
22	(a) 5 percent in 2018;		
23	(b) 10 percent in 2019;		
24	(c) 15 percent in 2020;		
25	(d) 20 percent in 2021;		
26	(e) 25 percent in 2022; and		
27	(f) 30 percent in 2023 and thereafter.		
28	(2) The principal of the trust shall forever remain inviolate unless appropriated by a vote of three-fourths		
29	of the members of each house of the legislature.

2	to amend the constitution, Article XIV, section 8, of the Montana constitution requires an affirmative roll call vot
