4	A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REVISING THE MONTANA CLEAN INDOOR AIR ACT RELATING
5	TO PRIVATE ESTABLISHMENTS; EXEMPTING CERTAIN BONA FIDE PRIVATE SOCIAL CLUBS FROM THE
6	ACT; AND AMENDING SECTION 50-40-104, MCA: AND PROVIDING APPLICABILITY DATES."
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8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
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10	Section 1. Section 50-40-104, MCA, is amended to read:
11	"50-40-104. Smoking in enclosed public places prohibited notice to public places where
12	prohibition inapplicable. (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section, smoking in an enclosed public place
13	is prohibited.
14	(2) The proprietor or manager of an establishment containing enclosed public places shall post a sign
15	in a conspicuous place at all public entrances to the establishment stating, in a manner that can be easily read
16	and understood, that smoking in the enclosed public place is prohibited.
17	(3) The proprietor or manager of an intrastate bus that is not chartered shall prohibit smoking in all parts
18	of the bus.
19	(4) The prohibition in subsection (1) does not apply to the following places, whether or not the public is
20	allowed access to those places:
21	(a) a private residence unless it is used for any of the following purposes, in which case the prohibition
22	in subsection (1) applies:
23	(i) a family day-care home or group day-care home, as defined in 52-2-703 and licensed pursuant to Title
24	52, chapter 2, part 7;
25	(ii) an adult foster care home, as defined in 50-5-101 and licensed pursuant to Title 50, chapter 5; or
26	(iii) a health care facility, as defined in 50-5-101 and licensed pursuant to Title 50, chapter 5;
27	(b) a private motor vehicle;
28	(c) school property in which smoking is allowed pursuant to the exception in 20-1-220;
29	(d) a hotel or motel room designated as a smoking room and rented to a guest; however, not more than
30	35% of the rooms available to rent to guests may be designated as smoking rooms; and

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1	(e) a site that is being used in connection with the practice of cultural activities by American Indians that
2	is in accordance with the American Indian Religious Freedom Act, 42 U.S.C. 1996 and 1996a; and
3	(f) a bona fide private social club, provided that any private social club contemplated by this section:
4	(I) is not a place of work as defined in 50-40-103;
5	(II) COMPLIES WITH SECTION 403.3 OF THE 2012 INTERNATIONAL MECHANICAL CODE OF MONTANA RELATING
6	TO VENTILATION OF BUILDINGS AND OUTDOOR AIRFLOW RATES;
7	(III) IS NOT LOCATED IN THE SAME BUILDING USED BY A PLACE OF WORK AND IS NOT LOCATED IN A BUILDING USED
8	BY THE PUBLIC; AND
9	(IV) DOES NOT ALLOW PEOPLE UNDER 21 YEARS OF AGE IN THE PRIVATE SOCIAL CLUB."
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11	NEW SECTION. Section 2. APPLICABILITY. (1) [THIS ACT] REQUIRES BONA FIDE PRIVATE SOCIAL CLUBS THAT
12	GO INTO OPERATION ON OR AFTER [THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ACT] TO COMPLY WITH THE 2012 INTERNATIONAL
13	MECHANICAL CODE OF MONTANA RELATING TO VENTILATION OF BUILDINGS AS OF [THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ACT].
14	BONA FIDE PRIVATE SOCIAL CLUBS IN EXISTENCE BEFORE [THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ACT] MUST COMPLY WITH THE
15	2012 INTERNATIONAL MECHANICAL CODE OF MONTANA BY OCTOBER 1, 2022.
16	(2) [THIS ACT] REQUIRES BONA FIDE PRIVATE SOCIAL CLUBS THAT GO INTO OPERATION ON OR AFTER [THE
17	EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ACT] TO COMPLY WITH 50-40-104(4)(F)(III). BONA FIDE PRIVATE SOCIAL CLUBS IN OPERATION
18	BEFORE [THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ACT] MAY CONTINUE OPERATING IN THE SAME LOCATION THAT WAS IN OPERATION
19	BEFORE [THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ACT]. HOWEVER, A BONA FIDE PRIVATE SOCIAL CLUB IN OPERATION BEFORE [THE
20	EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ACT] THAT CHANGES LOCATIONS MUST COMPLY WITH 50-40-104(4)(F)(III).



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
