9	Section 1. Section 61-6-303, MCA, is amended to read:
10	"61-6-303. Exempt vehicles. The following vehicles and their drivers are exempt from the provisions
11	of 61-6-301:
12	(1) a vehicle owned by the United States government or any state or political subdivision;
13	(2) a vehicle for which cash, securities, or a bond has been deposited or filed with the department upon
14	terms and conditions providing the same benefits available under a required motor vehicle liability insurance
15	policy;
16	(3) a vehicle owned by a self-insurer certified as provided in 61-6-143;
17	(4) an implement of husbandry or special mobile equipment that is only incidentally operated on a
18	highway or property open to use by the public;
19	(5) a vehicle operated upon on a highway only for the purpose of crossing the highway from one property
20	to another;
21	(6) a commercial vehicle registered or proportionally registered in this and any other jurisdiction if the
22	vehicle is covered by a motor vehicle liability insurance policy complying with the laws of another jurisdiction in
23	which it is registered;
24	(7) a motorcycle or quadricycle, as defined in 61-1-101;
25	(8) a vehicle moved solely by human or animal power; and
26	(9) a vehicle owned by a nonresident if it is currently registered in the owner's resident jurisdiction and
27	the owner is in compliance with the motor vehicle liability insurance requirements, if any, of that jurisdiction:
28	(10) A MOTORCYCLE DESIGNED FOR OFF-ROAD RECREATIONAL USE UNLESS IT HAS BEEN MODIFIED TO MEET THE
29	EQUIPMENT STANDARDS SPECIFIED IN CHAPTER 9 AND HAS BEEN REGISTERED FOR HIGHWAY USE; AND
30	(11) A MOPED. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, A MOPED MEANS A VEHICLE EQUIPPED WITH TWO OR

1 THREE WHEELS, FOOT PEDALS TO PERMIT MUSCULAR PROPULSION, AND AN INDEPENDENT POWER SOURCE PROVIDING 2 A MAXIMUM OF 2 BRAKE HORSEPOWER.
