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11	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
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13	Section 1. Section 37-15-301, MCA, is amended to read:
14	"37-15-301. License required exception rulemaking. (1) A license must be issued to qualified
15	persons either in speech-language pathology or audiology. A person may be licensed in both areas if the
16	person meets the respective qualifications, and in those instances, the license fee must be as though for one
17	license.
18	(2) A person may not practice or represent to the public that the person is a speech-language
19	pathologist, an audiologist, a speech-language pathology assistant, or an audiology assistant in this state
20	unless the person is licensed in accordance with the provisions of this chapter.
21	(3) The board may issue a limited license to qualified individuals engaged in supervised
22	professional experience, as defined by board rule.
23	(4) The board shall establish by rule the qualifications and scope of work for speech-language
24	pathology aides and audiology aides. A speech-language pathology aide or audiology aide:
25	(a) is not required to be licensed by the board;
26	(b) shall work under the supervision of a speech-language pathologist or an audiologist a minimum
27	of 20% of the time; and
28	(c) may not perform work that requires the independent judgment of a speech-language



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1 pathologist or audiologist."

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
