Section 1. Appropriation of cultural and aesthetic grant funds -- priority of 13 disbursement. (1) The Montana arts council shall award grants for projects authorized by and limited to the 14 amounts appropriated by [section 2] and this section. Money must be disbursed in priority order, first to projects 15 covered under subsection (3) and second to projects listed in [section 2]. 16 (2) The Montana arts council shall disburse money to projects authorized by [section 2] through grant 17 contracts between the Montana arts council and the grant recipient. The award contract must bind the parties to 18 conditions, if any, listed with the appropriation in [section 2]. 19 (3) There is appropriated from the cultural and aesthetic projects trust fund account to the Montana historical society \$30,000 for the biennium ending July 1, 2013, for care and conservation of capitol complex 20 21 artwork. 22 23 NEW SECTION. Section 2. Appropriation of cultural and aesthetic grant funds.
