4	A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REVISING THE DAYTIME MAXIMUM SPEED LIMITS FOR CERTAIN
5	VEHICLES TRAVELING ON CERTAIN HIGHWAYS; AND AMENDING SECTION 61-8-303, MCA."

7	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9	Section 1. Section 61-8-303, MCA, is amended to read:
10	<b>"61-8-303. Speed restrictions.</b> (1) Except as provided in 61-8-309, 61-8-310, and 61-8-312, the speed
11	limit for vehicles traveling:
12	(a) on a federal-aid interstate highway outside an urbanized area of 50,000 population or more is 75 85
13	miles an hour at all times and the speed limit for vehicles traveling on federal-aid interstate highways within an
14	urbanized area of 50,000 population or more is 65 miles an hour at all times;
15	(b) on any other public highway of this state is 70 80 miles an hour during the daytime and 65 miles an
16	hour during the nighttime;
17	(c) in an urban district is 25 miles an hour.
18	(2) A vehicle subject to the speed limits imposed in subsection (1) traveling on a two-lane road may
19	exceed the speed limits imposed in subsection (1) by 10 miles an hour in order to overtake and pass a vehicle
20	and return safely to the right-hand lane.
21	(3) Subject to the maximum speed limits set forth in subsection (1), a person shall operate a vehicle in
22	a careful and prudent manner and at a reduced rate of speed no greater than is reasonable and prudent under
23	the conditions existing at the point of operation, taking into account the amount and character of traffic, visibility,
24	weather, and roadway conditions.
25	(4) Except when a special hazard exists that requires lower speed for compliance with subsection (3),
26	the limits specified in this section are the maximum lawful speeds allowed.
27	(5) "Daytime" means from one-half hour before sunrise to one-half hour after sunset. "Nighttime" means
28	at any other hour.
29	(6) The speed limits set forth in this section may be altered by the transportation commission or a local
30	authority as authorized in 61-8-309, 61-8-310, 61-8-313, and 61-8-314."
