13	"7-6-2403. Qualifications of county auditor. A person is not eligible to serve in the office of county
14	auditor of any county unless the person:
15	(1) is of voting age <u>;</u> and
16	(2) has been a resident of the county for which the person is elected or appointed for at least 2 years
17	preceding election or appointment <u>; and</u>
18	(3) is a certified public accountant licensed to practice in this state pursuant to Title 37, chapter 50."
