11	WHEREAS, a child's parent or guardian is best poised to determine that child's intellectual, emotional,					
12	and physical maturity; and					
13	WHEREAS, the Legislature wishes to protect and promote the right of parents to raise their own

16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

18	NEW SEC	CTION. Section 1. Reasonable childhood independence. A parent or guardian of a child				
19	does not violate a	duty of care, protection, or support by permitting the child to engage in independent activities				
20	consistent with the child's intellectual, emotional, and physical maturity, including:					
21	(1) tra	aveling to and from school by walking, running, bicycling, public transit, or other means;				
22	(2) tra	aveling to and from nearby commercial or recreational facilities;				
23	(3) er	ngaging in outdoor play;				
24	(4) re	emaining for less than 15 minutes in a vehicle if the temperature inside the vehicle is not or will				
25	not become dangerously hot or cold;					
26	(5) re	emaining at home if the parent or guardian:				
27	(a) re	eturns home the same day on which the parent or guardian gives the child permission to				
28	remain at home;
