10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

12	SECTION 1. SECTION 81-7-501, MCA, IS AMENDED TO READ:
13	"81-7-501. Aerial hunting prohibited exceptions. (1) Except as provided in 81-7-505, a person,
14	except an employee of the state, its subdivisions, or the federal government who is acting within the scope of the
15	person's employment, may not engage in the aerial hunting of predatory animals, as defined in 81-7-101, without
16	first obtaining a permit from the department of livestock. The permit must specify the species of predatory animals
17	to be hunted and the geographic areas over which aerial hunting may take place. For purposes of this section,
18	the term predatory animal as defined in 81-7-101 does not include species managed or protected subject to Title
19	<u>87.</u>
20	(2) A person issued a permit as required by this section may not engage in aerial hunting of predatory
21	animals in violation of the terms of the permit, the rules promulgated by the board of livestock, or the terms of this
22	part."

24	SECTION 2. SECTION 81-7-505, MCA, IS AMENDED TO READ:
25	"81-7-505. Resident landowners authorized to aerially hunt over their own lands without permit
26	conditions. Any landowner having residence and domicile in Montana may engage in the aerial hunting of
27	predatory animals, as defined in 81-7-101, over that person's own land without a permit, provided the landowner
28	annually notifies the department in writing that the landowner will be engaged in aerial hunting and gives an
29	adequate description of the location of the land over which the landowner will aerially hunt. Aerial hunting must
30	be in accordance with all rules of the department of livestock. For purposes of this section, the term predatory
