2	INTRODUCED BY B. HAMLETT

4	A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF
5	MONTANA REQUIRING AN INTERIM STUDY OF HOW THE NATURAL STREAMBED AND LAND
6	PRESERVATION ACT OF 1975 IS BEING IMPLEMENTED.
7	
8	WHEREAS, the Legislature enacted the Natural Streambed and Land Preservation Act of 1975 as Title
9	75, chapter 7, part 1, with the intent to minimize soil erosion and sedimentation and to protect perennial-flowing
10	streams when a project is proposed in or near a stream; and
11	WHEREAS, the law is implemented by conservation districts through what is commonly known as a 310
12	permit, which regulates projects in or near a perennial-flowing stream; and
13	WHEREAS, a need has arisen to further define a perennial-flowing stream and to distinguish a
14	perennial-flowing stream from intermittent streams and ephemeral streams; and
15	WHEREAS, legislative guidance during the interim is needed to ensure that the law is implemented in
16	the same manner statewide.
17	
18	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
19	STATE OF MONTANA:
20	That the Legislative Council be requested to designate an appropriate interim committee, pursuant to
21	section 5-5-217, MCA, or direct sufficient staff resources to examine the implementation of The Natural
22	Streambed and Land Preservation Act of 1975.
23	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the interim committee receive updates from conservation districts that
24	are working to revise 310 permit rules and examining how to distinguish a perennial-flowing stream from
25	intermittent and ephemeral streams.
26	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that if the study is assigned to staff, any findings or conclusions be
27	presented to and reviewed by an appropriate committee designated by the Legislative Council.
28	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all aspects of the study, including presentation and review
29	requirements, be concluded prior to September 15, 2014.
30	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the final results of the study, including any findings, conclusions,
