OVERVIEW: Section 9G.10 of S.L. 2022-74 requires the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health, from a total of \$2,585,000 in nonrecurring funds for the 2022-23 fiscal year that it was appropriated from the Local Project Reserve, to allocate those funds to nonprofit pregnancy centers as follows:

- \$260,000 to Davie Pregnancy Care Center, Inc.
- \$325,000 to Heartbeats A Pregnancy Care Center, Inc.
- \$500,000 to Open Arms Pregnancy Support Services, Inc.
- \$100,000 to Salem Pregnancy Support Center, Inc.
- \$150,000 to H.E.L.P. Center, Inc.
- \$250,000 to Cabarrus Women's Center, Inc.
- \$250,000 to Coastal Pregnancy Care Center, Inc.
- \$250,000 to Havelock Pregnancy Resource Center.
- \$250,000 to Eastern Pregnancy Information Clinic.
- \$250,000 to International Athletes' Abolition Mission, to support 1st Choice Pregnancy Resources of Pamlico County.

This section became effective July 1, 2022.
