OVERVIEW: *House Bill 296 would adopt the Veterans History Museum of the Carolinas as the official Veterans History Museum of North Carolina.*

CURRENT LAW: Chapter 145 of the General Statutes adopts the following State museums:

- G.S. 145-21. State Aviation Hall of Fame and Museum and State Museum of Aviation.
- G.S. 145-49. State Fly Fishing Museum.

BILL ANALYSIS: House Bill 296 would adopt the Veterans History Museum of the Carolinas, located in Transylvania County, as the official Veterans History Museum of North Carolina.

EFFECTIVE DATE: The act would be effective when it becomes law.
