**OVERVIEW:** *Section 1.3 of S.L. 2023-63 adds a twelfth member to the Board of Agriculture, who must be actively involved in the equine industry to represent the equine industry of the State.*

*This bill was vetoed by the Governor on June 23, 2023, and that veto was overridden by the General Assembly on June 27, 2023.*

*This section became effective June 27, 2023.*

## **BILL ANALYSIS:**

Under prior law, the Board of Agriculture had 11 members, all appointed by the Governor by and with the consent of the Senate. The members represent different specialties within the agriculture industry.

**Section 1.3** adds a twelfth member to the Board of Agriculture, who must be actively involved in the equine industry to represent the equine industry of the State.

## **EFFECTIVE DATE:**

This bill was vetoed by the Governor on June 23, 2023, and that veto was overridden by the General Assembly on June 27, 2023.

This section became effective June 27, 2023.
