

## SENATE BILL 762: North Carolina Farm Act of 2022, Section 5: Farmed Cervid Assessment Clarification

OVERVIEW: Section 5 of S.L. 2022-55 specifies that farmed cervid feed means commercial feed sold to a cervid farmer for farmed cervid use, rather than commercial feed labeled or marketed for farmed cervid use.

This section became effective July 8, 2022.

**CURRENT LAW AND BILL ANALYSIS: Section 5** of S.L. 2022-55 makes a clarifying change to the definition of "farmed cervid feed" for purposes of the farmed cervid assessment. This section specifies that farmed cervid feed means commercial feed sold to a cervid farmer for farmed cervid use, rather than commercial feed labeled or marketed for farmed cervid use. Commercial feed for cervids is often labeled for hunting purposes rather than farming.

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** This section of the act became effective July 8, 2022.
