A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT ALLOWING THE CAREGIVER OF A PERSON WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS FOR CURBSIDE VOTING TO ALSO VOTE USING CURBSIDE VOTING.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 163A-1140, as amended by Section 3.1(d) of S.L. 2018-144, reads as rewritten:

"§ 163A-1140. Curbside voting.

(a) In any election or referendum, if any qualified voter is able to travel to the voting place, but because of age or physical disability and physical barriers encountered at the voting place is unable to enter the voting enclosure to vote in person without physical assistance, that voter shall be allowed to vote either in the vehicle conveying that voter or in the immediate proximity of the voting place. A qualified voter who is a caregiver transporting a voter voting under this section shall be allowed to vote using curbside voting, provided only one caregiver per vehicle shall be allowed to vote pursuant to this section.

...."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to elections held on or after that date.
