1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT PLACING A CAP ON INSURANCE REFERRAL FEES PAID TO NONLICENSED  
3 PERSONS.  
4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:  
5 SECTION 1. G.S. 58-33-82 reads as rewritten:  
6 "§ 58-33-82. Commissions.  
7 ...  
8 (f) With respect to a referral of insurance business to a licensed insurance agent or broker,  
9 a commission, fee, or other valuable consideration paid to an unlicensed person under subsection  
10 (e) of this section shall not exceed fifty dollars (\$50.00) in value. In addition to any other penalties  
11 authorized by law, a violation of this subsection may be punishable by a fine of not more than  
12 two thousand dollars (\$2,000) for each violation."  
13 SECTION 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 2023, and applies to any referral  
14 of insurance business made after that date.
