- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 20.1-13-10 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to towing an individual on water skis or similar devices.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 20.1-13-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 20.1-13-10. Water skis and surfboard Penalty.
- No personAn individual may not manipulate any water skis, surfboard, or similar
 device without wearing a life preserver approved by the department, unless the
 individual is sixteen years of age or older and engaged in windsurfing or boardsailing.
 - 2. No personAny time between one hour after sunset to one hour before sunrise, an individual may not operate a vessel on any waters of this state towing a person or personsan individual on water skis, a surfboard, or similar device, nor may any personengage in water skiing, surfboarding, or similar activity at any time between the hours from one hour after sunset to one hour before sunrise.
 - 3. The provisions of subsections Subsections 1 and 2 do not apply to a performer engaged in a professional exhibition or a personan individual engaged in an activity authorized under section 20.1-13-11, and the provisions of subsection 1 do not apply to a person sixteen years of age or older engaged in windsurfing or boardsailing.
 - 4. No personAn individual may not operate or manipulate any vessel, towrope, or other device by which the direction or location of water skis, a surfboard, or similar device may be affected or controlled in such a way as to cause the water skis, surfboard, or similar device, or any person thereonan individual on the same, to collide with or strike against any object or personindividual.

- 1 No personAn individual may not operate a vessel on any waters of this state towing a 2 person or personsan individual on water skis, a surfboard, or similar device unless 3 there is another personindividual in the towing vessel observing the person or-4 personsindividual being towed or the vessel is not a personal watercraft and is 5 equipped with a mirror at least seventy-eight square inches [198.12 square] 6 centimeters] that provides the operator an unobstructed wide field of vision to the rear. 7 However, this subsection does not apply to members of any organization regularly 8 staging water ski shows, tournaments, or exhibitions while engaged in the 9 performance of suchthese shows, tournaments, or exhibitions. The department shall 10 adopt rules under section 20.1-13-11 to allow suchthese organizations to practice in 11 preparation for suchthese events, as prescribed in section 20.1-13-11.
 - 6. Any personAn individual who violates this section is guilty of a class 2 noncriminal offense.
