- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact section 54-12-32 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to ignition interlock and the twenty-four seven sobriety program; and amend and
- 3 reenact subsection 7 of section 39-08-01 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the
- 4 twenty-four seven sobriety program.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 7 of section 39-08-01 of the North Dakota Century
 Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - 7. As used in this title, participation in the twenty-four seven sobriety program under chapter 54-12 means compliance with sections 54-12-27 through 54-12-3154-12-32, and requires sobriety breath testing twice per day seven days per week or electronic alcohol monitoring, urine testing, or drug patch testing. The offender is responsible for all twenty-four seven sobriety program fees and the court may not waive the fees.
- SECTION 2. Section 54-12-32 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 15 <u>54-12-32. Ignition interlock in twenty-four seven sobriety program.</u>
- Notwithstanding any other provision of law, if the director of the department of transportation
- has issued a temporary restricted license to an individual who has a suspended license under
- 18 <u>chapter 39-20 or after a violation of section 39-08-01 or equivalent ordinance, and the individual</u>
- 19 <u>is participating in the twenty-four seven sobriety program, the attorney general may allow</u>
- 20 <u>ignition interlock instead of twice per day breath alcohol testing and other alcohol testing.</u>
