- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 54-12 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the expansion of existing school safety and crisis reporting programs;
- 3 and to provide for a continuing appropriation.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 54-12 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- School safety and crisis reporting programs Confidentiality of records Continuing
  appropriation.
- 1. The attorney general shall encourage and promote the use of statewide and
  10 locally-selected school safety and crisis reporting programs.
- 11 <u>2.</u> <u>If funding becomes available, the attorney general may:</u>
- 12 <u>a. Expand a statewide program to include tailored reporting mechanisms targeted to</u>
  13 <u>incidents of bullying and physical or sexual abuse; and</u>
- b. Conduct outreach to promote awareness of statewide or locally-selected school
  safety and crisis reporting programs.
- 3. All records or information related to the operation of the programs described in
  subsection 1 are exempt records as defined in section 44-04-18.1.
- The attorney general may seek and accept gifts, grants, and donations from any source for the purpose of carrying out its duties under this section. All moneys
  received as gifts, grants, and donations are appropriated to the attorney general on a continuing basis for the purpose of carrying out this section.
- 5. The attorney general may adopt rules necessary to administer the duties required to
  carry out this section.
