- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 57-28, relating to the priority of
- 2 liens; to amend and reenact sections 47-18-01, 47-18-04, 47-18-18, and 57-28-03 of the North
- 3 Dakota Century Code, relating to the homestead exemption, declaration of a homestead, and
- 4 the contents of a tax lien.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 47-18-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 8 47-18-01. Homestead exemption Area and value.
- 9 The homestead of anyan individual, whether married or unmarried, residing in this 10 state consists of the land upon on which the claimant resides, and the dwelling house 11 on that land in which the homestead claimant resides, with all its appurtenances, and 12 all other improvements on the land, the. The total value of the homestead may not to-13 exceed one hundred fifty thousand dollars in value, over and above liens or 14 encumbrances or both, unless the claim arises from property taxes or special 15 assessments accruing and levied on the homestead, then the homestead is equal to 16 the total value of the homestead.
 - <u>2.</u> The homestead <u>shall beis</u> exempt from judgment lien and from execution or forced sale, except as otherwise provided in this chapter.
 - 3. The homestead may not embrace different lots or tracts of land unless the lots or tracts of land are contiguous. For purposes of this section, "contiguous" means two or more tracts of real property which share a common point or which would share a common point but for an intervening road or right of way.
 - **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 47-18-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

8	3.	On debts created for the purchase thereof and for all taxes accruing and levied-
9		thereonof the homestead.
10	4.	On all other debts, excluding property taxes and special assessments accruing and
11		levied on the homestead, when, upon an appraisal as provided by section 47-18-06, it
12		appears that the value of the homestead is more than one hundred fifty thousand
13		dollars over and above liens or encumbrances on the homestead, and then only to the
14		extent of any value in excess of the sum total of the liens and encumbrances plus said
15		one hundred fifty thousand dollars.
16	SEC	TION 3. AMENDMENT. Section 47-18-18 of the North Dakota Century Code is
17	amende	d and reenacted as follows:
18	47- 1	8-18. Declaration of homestead - How executed and acknowledged.
19	<u>1.</u>	In order to select a homestead the:
20		<u>a.</u> <u>The</u> claimant shall execute and acknowledge, in the same manner as a grant of
21		real property is acknowledged, a declaration of homestead, and file the
22		declaration for record.
23		<u>b.</u> A claim of a homestead by a debtor who received a discharge is a declaration of
24		homestead.
25		c. Filing for record in the recorder's office of the county where the homestead is
26		located a certified copy with the legal description of the discharge constitutes
27		notice that the property is a homestead and exempt from judgments.
28	<u>2.</u>	A declaration executed under this section is executed under penalty of perjury.

SECTION 4. AMENDMENT. Section 57-28-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is

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- 1 57-28-03. Contents of notice of tax lien.
- 2 Notice of foreclosure of tax lien must include:
- 3 1. The description of the property.
- The amount of delinquent property taxes and special assessments, with penalties, interest, and foreclosure costs, for the tax year foreclosed.
- 6 3. The total amount required to satisfy the property tax lien.
- 7 4. The time when the foreclosure will occur.
- 5. Information related to the homestead exemption in chapter 47-18, including the
 process to claim a property as a homestead.
- SECTION 5. A new section to chapter 57-28 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 12 <u>Lien priority.</u>
- A lien for unpaid property taxes or special assessments under this chapter has priority over
- 14 any judgment, mortgage, or other lien or claim entered against the real property except for liens
- under section 35-34-02.1. A lien for property taxes has priority over a lien for special
- 16 <u>assessments.</u>
