- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 57-02-27.1 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to determination of the true and full valuation of property; and to provide an effective
- 3 date.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 57-02-27.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 7 57-02-27.1. Property to be valued at true and full value.
- 8 All assessors and boards of equalization shall place the values of all items of taxable
- 9 property at the true and full value of the property except as otherwise specifically provided by
- 10 law, and the amount of taxes that may be levied on such property must be limited as provided in
- 11 this chapter. For the purposes of sections 57-02-27, 57-02-27.1, 57-02-27.2, and 57-55-04, the
- 12 term "true and full value" has the same meaning as provided in subsection 15 of section
- 13 57-02-01, except that "true and full value" of agricultural lands must be as determined pursuant
- to section 57-02-27.2. <u>The appraised valuation of taxable property must be substituted for the</u>
- 15 true and full valuation of the property, as determined by an assessor or board of equalization, if
- 16 the owner of the property provides the assessor or a board of equalization an appraisal
- prepared by a licensed appraiser, as defined in section 43-23.3-01, which was completed no
- 18 <u>longer than thee years before the taxable year for which the valuation of the property is being</u>
- 19 <u>determined for purposes of taxation.</u>
- The governing body of the city or township may establish valuations that recognize the
- 21 supply of vacant lots available for sale.
- 22 **SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Act is effective for taxable years beginning after
- 23 December 31, 2018.
