4 SECTION 1. SPECIAL EDUCATION FUNDING COMMITTEE - REPORT TO

5 LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT.

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- During the 2025-26 interim, the legislative management shall establish and provide staffing and administrative services to a committee to study special education funding. The chairman of legislative management may add temporary, nonvoting members to the committee, as deemed necessary by the committee, to serve without
- compensation. 11 2. The committee may include:
- 12 Five members of the legislative assembly, appointed by the legislative 13 management;
- 14 b. Two multi-unit special education directors;
- 15 One large school special education director; C.
 - One special education coordinator; d.
- 17 e. One superintendent of a large school;
- 18 f. One superintendent of a small or midsize school;
- 19 One business manager of a large school; and g.
- 20 h. One multi-unit special education business manager.
- 21 3. During the 2025-26 interim, the special education funding committee study must 22 include a comprehensive review of special education funding models, including 23 student contracts, high-cost students, residential placement, and reimbursement under 24 the Medicaid program.
