- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 29-01 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to law enforcement use of a drone or robot.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 29-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 6 Use of drones and robots.
- 7 <u>1. A law enforcement officer may not use a drone or robot to:</u>
- a. <u>Issue or serve an arrest warrant or summons in lieu of a warrant upon complaint</u>
 under Rule 4 of the North Dakota Rules of Criminal Procedure;
- 10 <u>b.</u> Take an individual into custody in the manner authorized by law to answer for the
 11 commission of an offense;
- 12 <u>c. Conduct hostage negotiations;</u>
- 13 <u>d. Manage traffic;</u>
- 14 <u>e. Gather evidence of a crime without a warrant; or</u>
- 15 <u>f. Monitor public events without a warrant.</u>
- This section does not apply to the use of a drone or robot for search and rescue of a
 missing individual, disposal of a bomb, or crime scene analysis.
