- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 1 of section 23-27-04 of the North Dakota Century 5 Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 1. An emergency medical services operation within this state may not operate unless the operation is licensed in accordance withunder this chapter and. The department shall adopt rules adopted by the department of health and human services. The rules for

- 18 g.h. The scope of practice for uncertified drivers, certified personnel, and emergency
 19 medical services professionals.;
- 20 <u>h.i.</u> Performance standards, which may include response time standards.; and
- 21 <u>i.j.</u> Other requirements as may be found necessary to carry out the intentrequirements of this chapter.
