1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 39-22-18 of the North Dakota Century Code,
2 relating to retail motor vehicle sales.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 39-22-18 of the North Dakota Century Code is
5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **39-22-18. Renewal of dealer license - Fees - Minimum sales requirement - Penalty.**

7 A dealer license issued under this chapter expires on December thirty-first of each year. A
8 licensed dealer may apply for renewal of the dealer's license on forms prescribed by the
9 department and payment of the dealer license and dealer plate fees required by this chapter.
10 The department ~~shall~~may not renew the dealer license of any applicant who has made less than
11 ~~four~~eight retail motor vehicle sales during the previous year. The department may adopt
12 administrative rules to limit the number of dealer plates available to an applicant based on the
13 applicant's motor vehicle sales history. Any dealer who fails to submit a renewal application
14 before the expiration of the dealer's current license, in addition to all other fees due, shall pay a
15 one hundred dollar fee at the time the dealer's license is renewed. For purposes of this section,
16 "retail motor vehicle sales" means the sale of a motor vehicle that requires titling and
17 registration in order to operate on the roads.
