- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide for a legislative management study relating to the management of
- 2 water based on watershed boundaries.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY WATER MANAGEMENT BASED
- 5 **ON WATERSHED BOUNDARIES.** During the 2025-26 interim, the legislative management
- 6 shall study the feasibility and desirability of assigning management authority for the waters of
- 7 the state to the area located in the naturally occurring watershed, rather than assigning
- 8 management authority based on political subdivision boundaries. The study must review the
- 9 approaches used for managing water in surrounding states; the powers, duties, and
- 10 organizational structure of watershed boards; dispute resolution procedures afforded to
- 11 individuals residing within the boundaries of a watershed district; the mechanism to initiate,
- 12 implement, and improve works projects within a watershed district; and the role of the
- 13 department of water resources in mapping and establishing watershed boundaries. The
- 14 legislative management shall report its findings and recommendations, together with any
- 15 legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the seventieth legislative assembly.
