1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new subsection to section 15-10-38.1 of the North

2 Dakota Century Code, relating to eligibility for the skilled workforce student loan repayment

3 program; and to amend and reenact subsection 4 of section 15-10-38.2 of the North Dakota

4 Century Code, relating to eligibility for the skilled workforce scholarship program.

5 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

6 **SECTION 1.** A new subsection to section 15-10-38.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is 7 created and enacted as follows:

- 8 The requirement under subdivision c of subsection 4 is met if an individual completed
- 9 <u>a master of science degree in nursing while teaching four clinical credits per year and</u>

10 resides and works in this state in an occupation requiring the degree.

11 SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Subsection 4 of section 15-10-38.2 of the North Dakota

12 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

- The state board of higher education and the workforce development council shall
 compile a list of qualifying educational programs annually. A qualifying educational
 program is:
- 16a.Is a program resulting in attainment of an associate's degree or lower credential17program that may be completed within four semesters, six quarters, or the final18two years of a baccalaureate program. A qualifying educational program also-19must
- <u>b.</u> <u>Must pertain to the professional and technical skills and emerging occupations in</u>
 high demand in this state, as determined under subsection 3. Qualifying
 educational programs may
- 23 <u>c.</u> <u>May</u> include degree or certificate programs.

1d.Notwithstanding any other requirements under this subsection, is a master of2science degree in nursing, if the individual teaches four clinical credits per3calendar year.
