1 A BILL for an Act to provide for the establishment of a center for independent living outreach
2 office on the Turtle Mountain Indian Reservation; and to provide an appropriation.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. CENTER FOR INDEPENDENT LIVING PILOT PROJECT - TURTLE**
5 **MOUNTAIN INDIAN RESERVATION.** The department of human services shall establish as a
6 two-year pilot project a center for independent living outreach office on the Turtle Mountain
7 Indian Reservation. The pilot project must provide training, networking, and resources to
8 individuals with disabilities, mobility impairments, and other special needs. The Turtle Mountain
9 Band of Chippewa Indians, as an in-kind contribution to the project, shall provide the land on
10 which the center is to be located.

11 **SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general
12 fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$420,000, or so much of the
13 sum as may be necessary, to the department of human services for the purpose of establishing
14 a center for independent living outreach office on the Turtle Mountain Indian Reservation as
15 described in section 1 of this Act, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30,
16 2017.
