1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 1 of section 39-06.1-10 and paragraph 33 of

2 subdivision a of subsection 3 of section 39-06.1-10 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating

3 to entries against a driving record.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 1 of section 39-06.1-10 of the North Dakota

6 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

- If a report of a conviction of a traffic offense, or admission or adjudication of a traffic
 violation is received by the director, the director shall proceed to enter the proper
- 8 violation is received by the director, the director shall proceed to enter the proper
- 9 points on the licensee's driving record, <u>unless no points are assigned to the violation</u>.
- 10 If no points are assigned to the violation, the violation may not be entered on the
- 11 driving record but must be recorded separately, and the separate record is not a public
- 12 record. If the driving record shows that the licensee has accumulated a total of twelve
- 13 or more points, assigned on the basis of the schedule contained in subsection 3, the
- 14 director shall notify the licensee of the director's intention to suspend the operator's
- 15 license under section 39-06-33. For the purposes of this chapter, the director also may
- receive and act on reports of traffic offense convictions forwarded by federal, military,
 and tribal courts in this state.

18 SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Paragraph 33 of subdivision a of subsection 3 of section

- 19 39-06.1-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 20 (33) On a highway on which the speed limit is posted in
- 21 excess of sixty-five miles [104.61 kilometers] an hour,
 - operating a motor vehicle in excess of the speed limit
- 23 in violation of section 39-09-02, or equivalent ordinance
