## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 15.1-27-35.3 of the North Dakota Century Code is

5 amended and reenacted as follows:

## 6 **15.1-27-35.3.** Payments to school districts - Unobligated general fund balance.

7	1.	a.	The superintendent of public instruction shall determine the amount of payments
8			due a school district and shall subtract from that the amount by which the
9			unobligated general fund balance of the district on the preceding June thirtieth is
10			in excess of forty percent of its actual expenditures, plus twenty thousand dollars.
11		b	BeginningExcept as provided in subdivision c, beginning July 1, 2017, the
12			superintendent of public instruction shall determine the amount of payments due
13			to a school district and shall subtract from that the amount by which the
14			unobligated general fund balance of the district on the preceding June thirtieth is
15			in excess of thirty-five percent of its actual expenditures, plus twenty fifty
16			thousand dollars.
17		<u>C.</u>	Beginning July 1, 2017, the superintendent of public instruction shall determine
18			the amount of payments due to a school district and shall subtract from that the
19			amount by which the unobligated general fund balance of the district on the
20			preceding June thirtieth is in excess of thirty-five percent of its actual
21			expenditures, plus one hundred thousand dollars if the school district is in a
22			cooperative agreement with another school district to share academic resources,
23			and the school districts are considering reorganization under chapter 15.1-12. An

- eligible school district may receive payments under this provision for a maximum
   of two years.
- 3 2. For purposes of this section, a district's unobligated general fund balance includes all
  4 moneys in the district's miscellaneous fund, as established under section 57-15-14.2.
