- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide a producer exemption for the slaughtering and processing of
- 2 poultry.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 SECTION 1.
- 5 <u>Poultry slaughter and processing Producer exemption.</u>
- 6 A poultry producer may slaughter and process on the producer's premises, up to twenty
- 7 thousand poultry per calendar year, provided:
- 8 <u>1. The poultry were raised by the producer;</u>
- 9 <u>2.</u> The poultry products are distributed by the producer only in this state;
- 10 <u>3. The poultry are healthy at the time of slaughter;</u>
- 11 <u>4.</u> The slaughter and processing are conducted using sanitary standards, practices, and
- 12 <u>procedures:</u>
- 13 <u>5.</u> The slaughter facility is not used to slaughter or process another person's poultry; and
- 14 <u>6. Each poultry shipping container bears:</u>
- 15 <u>a. The producer's name;</u>
- 16 <u>b. The producer's address; and</u>
- 17 c. The following statement: "Exempt P.L. 90-492".
