6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1	Section 1. Section 60-601, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
2	2016, is amended to read:
3	60-601 Sections 60-601 to 60-6,383 <u>and section 2 of this act</u> shall
4	be known and may be cited as the Nebraska Rules of the Road.
5	Sec. 2. <u>A driver in a vehicle on any roadway other than a</u>
6	controlled-access highway who is approaching a vehicle operated by a
7	towing or vehicle recovery service, a publicly or privately owned utility
8	<u>maintenance vehicle, a highway maintenance vehicle, or a vehicle operated</u>
9	by a solid waste or recycling collection service which is stopped and
10	<u>displaying flashing red, yellow, or amber lights shall, unless otherwise</u>
11	directed by a law enforcement officer, proceed with due care and caution
12	and:
13	(1) Move into another lane that is at least one moving lane apart
14	from the stopped vehicle if possible under existing traffic and safety
15	<u>conditions; or</u>
16	(2) If such a lane change is impossible, unsafe, or prohibited by
17	law, reduce speed to a reasonable speed below the posted speed limit and
18	<u>be prepared to stop.</u>
