LB 1028

1 Section 1. The Department of Health and Human Services 2 shall apply to the United States Department of Health and Human 3 Services for a grant under the State Balancing Incentives Payment 4 Program enacted in the federal Patient Protection and Affordable Care 5 Act, 42 U.S.C. 18001 et seq. Funds from the grant shall be used to 6 develop a comprehensive and coordinated system of home and community-7 based long-term care services. The department shall file the grant 8 application not later than September 1, 2012, and the application 9 shall meet the requirements of section 10202 of the federal Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act. 10 11 Sec. 2. On or before December 1, 2012, the Department of 12 Health and Human Services shall report to the Health and Human 13 Services Committee of the Legislature on the status of the grant
