# **LEGISLATIVE BILL 1202**

#### Committee:

- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to child support enforcement; to amend section
- 2 43-3342.04, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change a
- 3 requirement relating to the customer service unit; and to repeal the
- 4 original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 43-3342.04, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska,
- 2 is amended to read:
- 3 43-3342.04 (1) The Title IV-D Division shall establish a Customer
- 4 Service Unit. In hiring the initial staff for the unit, a hiring
- 5 preference shall be given to employees of the clerks of the district
- 6 court. The duties of the Customer Service Unit include, but are not
- 7 limited to:
- 8 (a) Providing account information as well as addressing inquiries
- 9 made by customers of the State Disbursement Unit; and
- 10 (b) Administering two statewide toll-free telephone systems, one for
- 11 use by employers and one for use by all other customers, to provide
- 12 responses to inquiries regarding income withholding, the collection and
- 13 disbursement of support order payments made to the State Disbursement
- 14 Unit, and other child support enforcement issues, including establishing
- 15 a call center with sufficient telephone lines, a voice response unit, and
- 16 adequate personnel available during normal business hours to ensure that
- 17 responses to inquiries are made by the division's personnel or the
- 18 division's designee.
- 19 (2) The physical location of the Customer Service Unit shall be in
- 20 Nebraska<del> and shall result in the hiring of a number of new employees or</del>
- 21 contractor's staff equal to at least one-fourth of one percent of the
- 22 labor force in the county or counties in which the Customer Service Unit
- 23 is located. Customer service staff responsible for providing account
- 24 information related to the State Disbursement Unit may be located at the
- 25 same location as the State Disbursement Unit.
- 26 (3) The department shall issue a report to the Governor and to the
- 27 Legislature on or before January 31 of each year which discloses
- 28 information relating to the operation of the State Disbursement Unit for
- 29 the preceding calendar year including, but not limited to:
- 30 (a) The number of transactions processed by the State Disbursement
- 31 Unit;

- 1 (b) The dollar amount collected by the State Disbursement Unit;
- 2 (c) The dollar amount disbursed by the State Disbursement Unit;
- 3 (d) The percentage of identifiable collections disbursed within two
- 4 business days;
- 5 (e) The percentage of identifiable collections that are matched to
- 6 the correct case;
- 7 (f) The number and dollar amount of insufficient funds checks
- 8 received by the State Disbursement Unit;
- 9 (g) The number and dollar amount of insufficient funds checks
- 10 received by the State Disbursement Unit for which restitution is
- 11 subsequently made to the State Disbursement Unit;
- 12 (h) The number of incoming telephone calls processed through the
- 13 Customer Service Unit;
- (i) The average length of incoming calls from employers;
- 15 (j) The average length of incoming calls from all other customers;
- 16 (k) The percentage of incoming calls resulting in abandonment by the
- 17 customer;
- 18 (1) The percentage of incoming calls resulting in a customer
- 19 receiving a busy signal;
- 20 (m) The average holding time for all incoming calls; and
- 21 (n) The percentage of calls handled by employees of the Customer
- 22 Service Unit that are resolved within twenty-four hours.
- 23 (4) The report issued to the Legislature pursuant to subsection (3)
- 24 of this section shall be issued electronically.
