Section 1. Section 71-216.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska,

- 2 is amended to read:
- 3 71-216.01 An applicant who fails to pass the barber examination may
- 4 take the examination a second time when the examination is offered by the
- 5 board without being required to take any further course of study. If an
- 6 applicant fails the examination a second time, the applicant shall be
- 7 required to complete a further course of study in barbering, consisting
- 8 of five hundred hours with not more than ten hours completed in any one
- 9 working day in a school of barbering. An applicant may have an
- 10 opportunity to test out of the course of study after completion of two
- 11 hundred fifty hours with the approval of the board. If such applicant
- 12 fails to test out of the examination after completion of two hundred
- 13 fifty hours, the applicant shall complete the remaining two hundred fifty
- 14 hours before such applicant shall be permitted to take the examination a
- 15 third time.
- 16 A graduate from a school of barbering who fails to pass a
- 17 satisfactory examination may take the examination next time that the
- 18 examination is given by the Board of Barber Examiners without being
- 19 required to take any further course of study. Should the applicant fail
- 20 the examination a second time, the applicant shall be required to
- 21 complete a further course of study of not less than five hundred hours to
- 22 be completed within three months of not more than ten hours in any one
- 23 working day in a school of barbering approved by the Board of Barber
- 24 Examiners before the applicant may be permitted to take the examination a
- 25 third time.
