- 6 (1) Clean Water Act means the federal Clean Water Act, as amended,
- 7 33 U.S.C. 1251 et seq.;
- 8 (2) Construction means any of the following: Preliminary planning to
- 9 determine the feasibility of wastewater treatment works or nonpoint
- 10 source control systems; engineering, architectural, legal, fiscal, or
- 11 economic investigations or studies; surveys, designs, plans, working
- 12 drawings, specifications, procedures, or other necessary preliminary
- 13 actions; erection, building, acquisition, alteration, remodeling,
- 14 improvement, or extension of wastewater treatment works or nonpoint
- 15 source control systems; or the inspection or supervision of any of the
- 16 foregoing items;
- 17 (3) Council means the Environmental Quality Council;
- 18 (4) County means any county authorized to construct a sewerage
- 19 disposal system and plant or plants pursuant to the County Industrial
- 20 Sewer Construction Act;
- 21 (5) Department means the Department of Environmental Quality;
- 22 (6) Director means the Director of Environmental Quality;
- 23 (7) Eligible financial institution means a bank that agrees to
- 24 participate in the linked deposit program and which is chartered to
- 25 conduct banking in this state pursuant to the Nebraska Banking Act, is
- 26 chartered to conduct banking by another state and authorized to do
- 27 business in this state, or is a national bank authorized to do business
- 28 in this state;
- 29 (8) Fund means the Wastewater Treatment Facilities Construction Loan
- 30 Fund;
- 31 (9) Linked deposit program means the Wastewater Treatment Facilities

- 1 Construction Assistance Act Linked Deposit Program established in
- 2 accordance with section 81-15,151.03;
- 3 (10) Municipality means any city, town, village, district,
- 4 association, or other public body created by or pursuant to state law and
- 5 having jurisdiction over disposal of sewage, industrial wastes, or other
- 6 wastes;
- 7 (11) Nonpoint source control systems means (a) projects which
- 8 establish the use of methods, measures, or practices to control the
- 9 pollution of surface waters and ground water that occurs as pollutants
- 10 are transported by water from diffuse or scattered sources. Such projects
- 11 include, but are not limited to, structural and nonstructural controls
- 12 and operation and maintenance procedures applied before, during, and
- 13 after pollution-producing activities. Sources of nonpoint source
- 14 pollution may include, but are not limited to, agricultural, forestry,
- 15 and urban lands, transportation corridors, stream channels, mining and
- 16 construction activities, animal feeding operations, septic tank systems,
- 17 underground storage tanks, landfills, and atmospheric deposition and (b)
- 18 projects which establish methods, measures, structures, or practices to
- 19 protect, remediate, or enhance any waters of the state or aquatic habitat
- 20 that are impacted by natural or anthropogenic nonpoint sources of
- 21 pollution. Types of projects include, but are not limited to, projects
- 22 which minimize or control runoff or leaching from activities in urban,
- 23 construction, or rural areas, erosion of sediment, atmospheric
- 24 <u>deposition</u>, or <u>similar causes or hydromodification projects</u>;
- 25 (12) Operate and maintain means all necessary activities including
- 26 the normal replacement of equipment or appurtenances to assure the
- 27 dependable and economical function of a wastewater treatment works or
- 28 nonpoint source control systems in accordance with its intended purpose;

- 30 (13) Wastewater treatment works means the structures, equipment, and
- 31 processes required to collect, transport, and treat domestic or
