- 1 Section 1. (1) For purposes of this section, real estate licensee
- 2 means a broker or salesperson who is licensed under the Nebraska Real
- 3 <u>Estate License Act.</u>
- 4 (2) Any action to recover damages based on any act or omission of a
- 5 real estate licensee relating to real estate brokerage services shall be
- 6 commenced within two years after whichever of the following occurs first
- 7 with respect to such brokerage services: (a) A transaction is completed
- 8 or closed; (b) an agency agreement is terminated; or (c) an unconsummated
- 9 transaction is terminated or expires. Such two-year period shall not be
- 10 <u>reduced by agreement and shall not apply to disciplinary actions</u>
- <u>initiated by the State Real Estate Commission.</u>
- 12 (3) If the cause of action described in subsection (2) of this
- 13 section is not discovered and could not be reasonably discovered within
- 14 the two-year period described in such subsection, then the action may be
- 15 commenced within one year from the date of such discovery or from the
- 16 date of discovery of facts which would reasonably lead to such discovery,
- 17 whichever is earlier, except that in no event may any such action be
- 18 commenced more than ten years after the date of rendering or failing to
- 19 render the brokerage services which provide the basis for the cause of
- 20 action.
- 21 Sec. 2. The Revisor of Statutes shall assign section 1 of this act
- 22 to Chapter 25, article 2.
